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ANNUAL ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT, 2020-21

1. INTRODUCTION

The Directorate of Economics and Statistics, Assam was set up in the year of 1948 to collect, compile and analysis of statistical data for preparation of various plan for the welfare of the State as well as the Country at large. Initially, the Directorate of Economics and Statistics, Assam was under the control of Finance Department, but later on, it is brought under the administrative control of Transformation and Development Department (then Planning and Development Department) by the Government of Assam. Presently, this Directorate is located in Jawaharnagar, Beltola, Guwahati-28 and performing all works from its own office building. Since the inception, the Directorate has been performing a quality based services to the Govt. for taking up fruitful plans and programmes for greater interest of the State. It publishes various reports to visualize the actual picture of economic growth and development of the State.

Vision and Mission of the Directorate: The main vision and mission of this Directorate is to transform the Office to an e-business Office, that is-

- ⇒ To Provide hardware and software facilities.
- ⇒ Provide internet connectivity
- ⇒ Data collection and compilation using web based software and CAPI solution Android device will be introduced.
- ⇒ Transform the Office to a paperless office converting all records to e- platform.
- ⇒ New data on village level statistics is planned to be collected with facility of gap analysis, as per departmental requirement.
- ⇒ Modify the web site to resourceful one.

1.1 ORGANISATION SET-UP

The Directorate has two regional offices headed by Joint Director of Economics and Statistics- one for Autonomous Hills District and another for Bodoland Territorial Region (BTR). In addition, there are 23 numbers of District and 13 numbers of Sub- Division Offices headed by Deputy Director and Sub-Divisional Statistical Officer respectively belonging to Assam Economic and Statistical Service (AESS). It is pertinent to mention here that at present out of 33 nos. of total District. But, the Directorate has only 23 nos. of District offices and 13 nos. Sub- Division Offices in the State. Another 7 Districts under this Directorate namely Dhemaji, Marigaon, Tinsukia, Charaideo, Majuli, Hojai and Biswanath are still working as Sub-Divisional level offices, whereas most of the other State Government offices are functioning with the status of district level. Moreover, the Directorate has no any office in the newly created Districts Kamrup Metro, South Salmara and Bajali, for which all the related works of these Districts are being run by the District Office Kamrup, Dhubri and Barpeta respectively.

The Village and Panchayat level statistics is very important for economic planning in the grass root level. So, keeping in view of the importance of village and Panchayat level statistics,

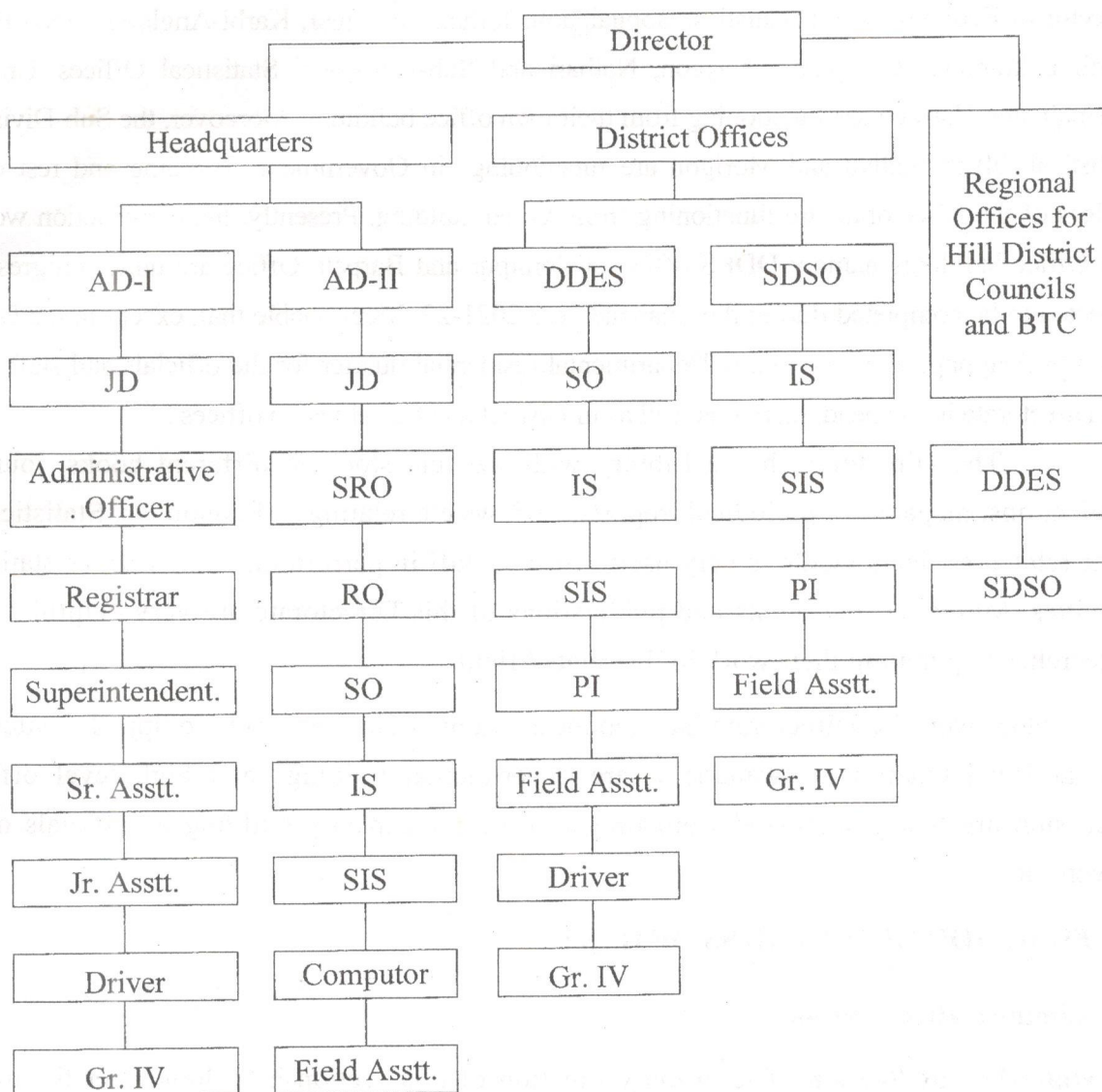
the State Government had created 134 nos. of post in the Community Development Block Office in the rank of Sub-Inspector of Statistics to collect, compile and maintain the statistical data for each and every village falling within the block jurisdiction. But unfortunately, out of the aforesaid 134 posts, 20 nos. of post have already been abolished by the Government. At present, due to vacant of some Block SIS posts, the works of Block level statistics are done mutually by SIS of District and Sub-Division Offices and Block SIS.

The organizational structure of the Directorate has been framed in the line as recommended by the committee to review the National Statistical System and consists of the following divisions.

1.2 ADMINISTRATIVE SET-UP : (Organogram)

1.3 ORGANISATION STRUCTURE (OFFICE BUILDING) :

The Headquarter of the Directorate of Economics and Statistics, Assam is functioning in its own office building located at Tripura Road, Jawaharnagar, Guwahati-28. At present, there are 13 (thirteen) offices namely the Joint Director of Economics and Statistics (Hills), Diphu, the Deputy Director of Economics and Statistics, Bongaigaon, Jorhat, Sivasagar, Karbi-Anglong, Dima-Hasao, North Lakhimpur, Goalpara, Nagaon, Nalbari and Sub-Divisional Statistical Offices Tinsukia, Dhemaji and Hamren are functioning from their own office buildings. Moreover, the Sub-Divisional Statistical Office Sadiya and Morigon are functioning in Government Building and rest of the Offices of the Directorate are functioning from rented building. Presently, the construction work of two Office buildings namely DDES office of Sonitpur and Barpeta Office are under progress and expected to be completed during the financial year 2021-22. Mentionable that, except in the District of Karbi-Anglong, there is no any Departmental residential quarter for the officials and staff under this Directorate in the head quarter as well as in District and Sub-division offices .

The Directorate has a Library with sizeable stock of different books, journals, publications, magazines, periodical, reports, reviews etc relating to Economics, Statistics and other related subjects which is very useful for the staff in performing their various statistical activities. Moreover, the books and publications of this Directorate are very helpful for the Researcher in pursuing their work in the related field.

Moreover, the Directorate has a modest Training Hall and well equipped Conference Hall at Head Quarter (Guwahati) where departmental trainings and high level officials discussion are being organized from time to time for capacity building of officials of the Directorate.

2. FUNCTION OF DIVISIONS OF H.Q. :

A) Administrative Division:

i) Establishment Section: The primary function of this section is to look after the overall administration, recruitment of Grade-IV, Driver and Grade-III Staff (Junior Assistant level) in non-technical category and Field Assistant, Primary Investigator/ Computer and Sub-Inspector of Statistics in Technical category. Maintaining and up-gradation of the service records of the staff, finalization of gradation list on seniority basis, promotion of different cadre up to Sub-Inspector of Statistics and dealing with pension and court cases etc.

ii) Account Section: Preparation and allocation of salary budget, preparation of monthly salary, TA Bills, GPF, GIS, pension related Bills and all other contingencies bills etc. The section also maintains the accounts of revenue and capital expenditure and prepare draft para to meet audit objection.

iii) Plan and Co-ordination Section : The primary activities of this section is to take follow-up action of construction of office building in the district and sub-division level under the Directorate and to maintain a constant liaison with the NSO (National Statistics Office) and other statistical organizations of the Central and State Government. Publication of Annual Administrative Report and Quarterly Statistical Newsletter are the regular routine work of this section. Besides this, this section coordinates the programme to celebrate the Statistics Day at the Headquarter.

(B) Technical Division :

(a) State Income Division : The primary function of this division is to prepare the analytic report of Assam Government Budget during budget session, estimation and compilation of State Domestic Product and District Domestic Product, Estimation of State Income and its related aggregate etc.

(b) Agriculture Statistics Division: Crop Estimation Survey, collection, compilation and maintaining of Agricultural Statistics, preparation of Land Utilisation Statistics Report and organize the Annual Refresher Training on Agriculture Statistics the main function of this division. Being the State Agricultural Statistics Authority (SASA), it analyses the crop area, average yield and production of 38 crops of Assam and related scheme like, TRS and ICS etc.

(c) Agriculture Census Division : There is a Agriculture Census Cell under this Directorate. The main function of this cell is to conduct Agriculture Census and keep close liaison with revenue dept. For timely completion of census works as per Govt. of India guidelines and prepare the report on Number of Operational holding, Area under Operational Holding and Average Size Class of Operational Holding of the state.

(d) Training Division : Arrangement of training programme for Junior Statistical personnel and take initiative to depute the officials to undergo training courses within and outside the State organized by Central and State Govt. Departments and other Agencies from time to time. For capacity building of Statistical Personal in various statistical fields this division has been performing a major role since the inception of this Directorate. But, due to Covid-19 Pandemic situation in Assam and rest of the Country to some extent the training programme couldn't be arranged during this period.

(e) Survey Division : Conducting National Sample Survey in different rounds, Employment and Unemployment Survey under the guidance of Labour Bureau, Government of India, are the main functions of this Division. Assam Government Employees Census and some ad-hoc survey are also conducted by this division from time to time and when necessary.

(f) Economic Study Division : The sole function of this division is to study and analyze of socio-economic data scenario of the State with details sector wise Socio-economic parameters to help planner and policy makers to find out future developmental rout map ushering in further economic growth and development. 'Economic Survey, Assam', is one of the important annual publications of this division.

(g) Statistical Data Division : The primary work of this Division is to collect, analysis and disseminate the statistical data collected from the various secondary sources (i.e. Govt., Non-Govt. organization). This division brings out the publications 'Statistical Handbook, Assam', 'Assam at a Glance' on annual basis. Besides this there is a another Sub-unit i.e. AIU attached with this Division. The main function of this section is to collect data from 219 Community Development Blocks and updating the Village Index Register and Block Information Register with different indicators viz. Agriculture, Forestry, Fishing, Classification of Workers etc. as well as analysis the same.

(h) Industry Division : Collection and compilation of Industrial data conducting Annual Survey of Industry, collect the Monthly Production Data from different selected Industries, Mines, Tea factories and Construction of IIP and Mineral Index etc., are the main activities of this division. Collection and Tabulation of industrial disputes data is another work of this division.

(i) Price Division: Collection of Farm Harvest Price, preparation Wholesale Price Index (WPI) Consumer Price Index (CPI), preparation of monthly statement of Wholesale Price of essential goods and collection and compilation of price of different building materials and wage rate of building construction's labours are the major works of this division.

(j) Information Technology and Data Processing Division: Data processing of various census and survey and update of web site of this Directorate are the main functions of this division. Besides above, for Strengthening the Directorate data base, one SSS Cell has already been established for smooth implementation Support for Statistical Strengthening (SSS) Scheme. Under this Scheme the Directorate has initiated some major study for bridging the data gap of the State.

2.1. FUNCTION OF DISTRICT AND SUB-DIVISIONAL OFFICES :

There are 23 District and 13 Sub-Divisional Offices of this Directorate. Presently, eight District level offices namely Tinsukia, Marigaon, Dhemaji and newly created Districts like Hojai, Majuli, Biswanath and Charaideo are functioning independently with Sub-Division level status because the status of this offices is yet to be upgraded to district level offices.

The primary function of all these District and Sub-Divisional offices is to assist the Headquarter in data collection, conducting Census/Survey, act as "Mini Directorate" within their own jurisdiction. The District level Offices are empowered to collect information regarding functions and activities as well as the status of implementation of various developmental activities/works executed by the Line Department offices functioning in the District level. Besides assisting the District Administration in various activities, these offices act as the convener of the District and Sub-Divisional Crop Forecast Committee Meetings at their respective jurisdictions.

District Hand Book, District at a Glance and District Socio-Economic Review are the three important annual publications published by the District offices focusing on the socio-economic scenario of a District.

The Sub-Inspectors of Statistics posted in the Community Development Blocks are under the administrative control of the District Officers. Collection, maintenance and update of Block Profile by incorporating information on implementation of various schematic development activities performed within the C.D. Blocks jurisdiction, maintenance and updating of Village Index Register and Block Information Register, are the primary functions to be discharged by the Sub-Inspectors under direct supervision of the District Officers.

3. MANPOWER

It is already mentioned that to collect, compile and analysis of statistical data for preparation of various plan for the welfare of the State as well as the Country at large the Directorate of Economics and Statistics, Assam was set up in the year of 1948.

At present, the total manpower strength under this Directorate is 1256 nos. as on 30th September 2021 out of 1256 post total 640 nos. of post of different cadres are lying vacant (i.e. more than 50% of total strength). Mentionable, that the Directorate has been suffering from manpower crisis since long. Of course, recently Govt. has approved 133 Nos. of post for recruitment against existing vacancy and accordingly advertisement has already been issued and other process are going on. More over, recruitment of 45 nos. of Inspector of Statistics has already been processed from Assam Public Service Commission.

The Total nos. of Gazetted, Non- Gazetted Officials including BTR and the posts held in the line Department as on September 2021 are depicted in the following Table.

4. Designated Officer and Activities under RTI Act 2005 :

There is a RTI Cell under the Directorate of Economics and Statistics, Assam at H.Q. Jawaharnagar Guwahati-28 as per provision of RTI Act 2005. One Joint Director level Officer is Designated as State Public Information Officer (SPIO) and one Research Officer is designated as ASPIO to look after the RTI matter. During 2021 total 6 Nos. of cases has been disposed from this Directorate. .

5. ON GOING CENTRAL SECTOR SCHEME :

The Directorate of Economics and Statistics is implementing the following State and Centrally Sponsored Schemes during this financial year 2020-21.

5.1. Timely Reporting Scheme (TRS): The Government of India has introduced 'Timely Reporting Scheme' (TRS) since 1973-74 with an aim to determine the timely estimates of area under 13 principal crops on the basis of 20 percent sample villages of the Plain Districts at the end of the each season viz. Early Kharif, Late Kharif, Rabi and Summer.

5.2. Improvement of Crop Statistics (ICS): The programme of supervision under the Improvement of Crop Statistics (ICS) Scheme has been carried out on equal matching basis with the NSSO (FOD), as per guideline of the Ministry of Agriculture and Programme Implementation, Government of India.

5.3. Agriculture Census: Agricultural Census is a central sector scheme which is conducted on quinquennial basis in the country for collection of data on structure of agricultural operational holdings and its related characteristics by different Size Classes, Social Groups and Gender. The Census is followed by Input Survey which provides key information about the application of inputs in the Agriculture Sector of the Country.

5.4. Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana : The PMFBY is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme introduced from the Kharif Season 2016 to provide insurance coverage and financial help to the farmers in the event of failure of nine notified crops i.e. Autumn Paddy, Winter Paddy, Summer Paddy, Jute, Black Gram, Wheat, Rape and Mustard, Potato and Sugar Cane. The Scheme is implemented in multi agency framework selected by insurance companies under the overall guidance and control of Agriculture Department. The main responsibility of this Directorate is to conduct the Crop Estimation Survey (CES) of the notified crop in the Panchayat level. But, presently due to non availability of Panchayat wise crop area data the directorate has been conducting the CES in Revenue Circle wise.

5.5. Support for Statistical Strengthening Scheme: Support for Statistical Strengthening (SSS) Scheme formerly known as Indian Statistical Strengthening Project (ISSP) with a aim to strengthen the State statistical system. It is a Central Sector sub-scheme with 100% funding from the Centre.

The Directorate of Economics and Statistics Assam has initiated to study 7 different survey for strengthening the Statistical System of the State and signed agreement with different reputed Institutions in Assam. Like UNDP, IIT Guwahati, Tezpur University, Omeo Kumar Das Institute of Social Change and Development (OKDISCD), Assam

University, Silchar. Among these surveys “Creation of Village Level data base for Assam” is one of the major survey which will cover the all Revenue Villages of State which has been being conducted by UNDP. Moreover, two major studies i.e. “Development Tourism Convenient Index” by Tezpur University and “Survey on Subsistence Fishing “ by Rastriya Gramin Vikash Nidhi (RGVN) has already been completed successfully and there report will publish very soon.

5.6. Rajiv Awas Yojona (RAY):

The Rajiv Awas Yojona (RAY) is a Centrally sponsored scheme implemented by Ministry of Housing and Urban Poverty Alleviation , Government of India. The main responsibility of this Directorate under the scheme is to collect the data on housing and building construction from the Urban Local Bodies/City Development Authorities and transmit the data to National Building Organization (NBO), which is a Nodal Agency of building statistics of Central Government, through BRIKS (Building Related Information Knowledge System) software.

6. Other Ongoing Schemes :

6.1. Sustainable Development Goal : In September, 2015 the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) adopted the resolution titled “Transforming Our World: the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development” consisting of 17 Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) to be achieved by 2030. The SDG contains 169 targets. These universal goal and targets involved both the development and developing countries like the MDGs (Millennium Development Goals) which primarily relevant for developing world. The inclusion agenda of SDGs lay balanced emphasis on the three pillars of sustainable development viz. economic growth, social development and environmental protection. The role of DES is to identify and selection of SDG indicators as well as establishment of robust monitoring structure which is imperative towards leading to a successful SDG monitoring implementation strategy at the state level.

6.2. Micro Fiscal Projection: In order to have a complete automation of different activities of the Directorate of Economics and Statistics, Assam. AMTRON has developed 6 (Six) Functional modules under MFP i.e. Agriculture, Industry, Statistical Data, Price, State Income, Survey and Four Administrative Module i.e. H.R.M.S. , Intra Net, Asset, Digital Archive. All the module are being operational for the Directorate.

7. CAPACITY BUILDING INITIATIVE DURING 2020-21(Training/Workshop) :

The Directorate has a modest training and well equipped Conference Hall at Head Quarter (Guwahati) where departmental training and high level officials discussion are being organized from time to time for capacity building of officials of the Directorate. In 2020 Directorate has organized a 45 days orientation training programme for capacity building of newly promoted Inspector of Statistics, but due to Covid-19 pandemic the course could not be completed. During the current year due to Covid-19 pandemic the Directorate has participated some virtual discussion and workshop and deputed Some Sr. Officers to the Assam Administrative Staff College, New Delhi and other places for different training programme and discussion organized by Govt. of India, Govt. of Assam and DoNER Ministry and NITY Aayog. Here is a table that shows the initiative has been taken.

8. MOU Details under this Directorate:-

The Support for Statistical Strengthen (SSS) the Scheme was awarded to The Directorate of Economics and Statistics Assam During 2017-18 and a MoU was signed between Govt. of India and Govt. of Assam. Further agreement was signed with some reputed Institution of the state for out sourcing some survey and studies. These Institutions are UNDP, Tezpur University, IIT Guwahati, RGVN, Assam University, Silchar, and Omeo Kumar Das Institute of Social Change and Development (OKDISCD) for conduct the different survey and Studies.

9. Details of Court Cases:-

At present there are 13 Nos. of W.P. (C) Court Cases is running under this Directorate filled by different employees and un-employment people relating to the ground of Compensatory appointment, Pension and Promotion etc.

10. New Initiative:-

The Directorate of Economics and Statistics Assam has initiated to study 8 different survey for strengthening the Statistical System of the State and signed agreement with Different reputed Institution in Assam. Likely. UNDP. IIT, Tezpur University, OKDSCD, Assam University, Silchar. Among these surveys "Creation of Village Level data base for Assam" is one of the major survey which will cover the all Revenue Villages of state which has been being conducted by UNDP. Moreover, two major studies i.e. "Development Tourism Convenient Index" by Tezpur University and " Survey on Subsistence Fishing " by Rastriya Gramin Vikash Nidhi (RGVN) has already been completed successfully and there report will publish very soon.

11. Publications :-

The Directorate has published some publications where large No. of Data and analysis reports are focused. The major publications of DES are –

Annual Publication : Statistical Handbook, Assam, Economic Survey of Assam, Annual Administrative Report, Land Utilization Statistics (LUS), Report on Area, Average Yield and Production of 38 Agricultural Crops of Assam. Besides these, the Directorate also publish Assam at Glance, Assam budget in Brief Report on State Domestic Product, District Domestic Product, Report on Gross Capital Formation and prepare Index of Industrial Product etc.

12. Other relevant to the Directorate:-

The Directorate of Economics and Statistics, Assam is mainly associated with the Ministry of Statistics and Program Implementation (MoSPI) GoI., Labour Bureau of India and DoNER Ministry. It is also associated with other Departments in term of data collection compilation and analysis i.e. Dept. of Finance, Agriculture, Revenue, Forestry, Fishery, Sericulture, Industry, Tourism, Social Welfare, Health, Education, Panchayat & Rural Development etc.
