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1. INTRODUCTION:

Directorate of Economics and Statistics (DES), Assam was set up in the month of February, 1948 under the control of Finance Department, but later on, it is brought under the administrative control of Planning & Development Department now it is known as Transformation and Development Department, Government of Assam.

The main objective for setting up of this Directorate is for collection, compilation and analyzing data on various fields as per requirement of the State as well as the Country.

This Directorate is the State nodal organization for estimation of State Domestic Product (SDP) or State Income and District Domestic Product (DDP) or District Income. DES, Assam acts as State Agricultural Statistics Authority and maintain the statistics on area, production, yield rates, etc. on the major crops of the state. This Directorate prepares and publishes "Economic Survey of Assam" "State Statistical Hand Book" in each & every year and place before the Hon'ble Assam Legislative Assembly in its Budget Session. Moreover DES also publishes "Statistical Atlas of the State", "Reports on Tea Statistics", "Reports on Annual Survey of Industries", "Reports on Socio Economic Survey" etc. on regular basis.

In the long history of this Directorate, the Statistical Data Base of the State has been transformed from physical to digitize form. People or any organization can easily asses the Statistical Data of the State in its web portal/site des.assam.govt.in

Vision and Mission of the Directorate: -The main vision and mission of this Directorate to transform the Office to an e-business Office, that is:

- ⇒ Data collection and compilation using web based software and CAPI solution/ Android device will be introduced.
- ⇒ Transform the Office to a paperless office converting all records to e-platform.

New data on village level statistics is planned to be collected with the facility of gap analysis, as per departmental requirement

2. ORGANISATIONAL STRUCTURE:

The Head office of Directorate of Economics and Statistics, Assam is located at Jawaharnaga, Beltola, Guwahati-28 and performing all works from its own office building. Since inception, this Directorate has been rendering quality based services to the Government for taking up need based plans and programmes for greater interest of the State.

Directorate of Economics and Statistics, Assam has two regional offices headed by the Joint Director of Economics and Statistics i.e. Office of the Joint Director of Economics and Statistics, Hills , Diphu for Hills Area Districts of Assam and other Office of the Joint Director of Economics and Statistics, Kokrajhar for Bodoland Territorial Region (BTR) Districts. In addition, there are 23 numbers of District and 13 numbers of Sub- Division offices headed by the Deputy Director of Economics & Statistics (DDES) and Sub-Divisional Statistical Officer (SDSO) respectively belonging to Assam Economic and Statistical Service (AESS).

It is pertinent to mention here that at present there are 23 nos. of District Office out of 35 nos. of total district and 13 nos. Sub- Division offices in the State. Moreover eight (8) Districts namely Dhemaji, Marigaon. Tinsukia, Charaideo, Majuli, Hojai, Biswanath and west Karbi-Anglong are still functioning by the respective Sub-Divisional level offices as these offices have not yet been upgraded to District offices.


Directorate has no any office in the newly created Districts i.e. Kamrup (M), South Salmara, Bajali and Tamulpur for which all the related works of these Districts are being run by their parent District Offices i.e. Kamrup, Dhubri, Barpeta and Baska Deputy Director office respectively.

6. DESIGNATED OFFICERS AND ACTIVITIES UNDER RTI ACT 2005:

There is a RTI Cell under the Directorate of Economics and Statistics, Assam at H.Q. Guwahati-28 as per provision of RTI Act, 2005. The Director of Economics and Statistics is the First Appellate Authority, one Joint Director of Economics and Statistics is designated as State Public Information Officer (SPIO) and one Senior Research Officer is designated as Assistant State Public Information Officer (ASPIO) along with a Junior Assistant to look after the RTI matter.

During 2024-25 total 6 (six) nos. of cases were received under the Act and responded accordingly.

7. FUNCTION OF DIFFERENT DIVISIONS UNDER THE DIRECTORATE:

A) Administrative Division:

Under this Division there are three sections namely Establishment Section, Account Section and Plan& Co-ordination Section.

i) Establishment Section:

The primary function of this section is to look after the overall administration. Maintaining and up-gradation of the service records of the staff, finalization of gradation list on seniority basis, promotion of different cadre up to the Sub-Inspector of Statistics level and dealing with Modified Assured Career Progression Schemes (MACPS), pension and court cases related work etc. are the major function of this section.

ii) Account Section:

The main function of this section are preparation and allocation of salary budget, preparation of monthly salary, TA Bills, GPF, NPS, GIS, Pension related Bills and all other contingencies bills etc. This section also maintains the accounts of revenue and capital expenditure and prepare draft para to meet audit objection.

iii) Plan and Co-ordination Section:

The primary activities of this section is to take follow-up action of construction of office building in the districts and sub-divisions under the Directorate and to maintain a constant liaison with the NSO (National Statistics Office) and other statistical organizations of the Central and State Government. Publication of Annual Administrative Report and Quarterly Statistical Newsletter are the regular routine work of this section. The section also coordinates the program to celebrate the National Statistics Day at the headquarter.

B) Technical Division:

i) State Income Division:

The primary function of this division is the estimation of Gross/Net State Domestic Product and Gross/Net District Domestic Product both at current as well as constant prices, estimation of State Income and its related aggregate, calculation of Per Capita Income as well as Economic Growth of the State Economy as per NSO guidelines, preparation of the report 'Assam Govt. Budget in Brief", economic cum purpose classification of the Assam Govt. Budget", calculation of Gross Fixed Capital Formation (GFCF) and Private Final Consumption Expenditure (PFCE), analysis of Local Bodies Budget, Autonomous Bodies Budget, Autonomous Councils Budget and Non-Departmental Enterprises (NDE) Budget etc.

The District Domestic Product (DDP) is the most important indicator to analyze the performance of various sectors of the economy and also the living

pattern of the population of the state. As the new vision towards the vision of Viksit Bharat@2047, districts are now considered as the fulcrum of economic growth and development. Income of each district covering all sectors of the district economy is now being estimated using 'Bottom-Up' approach. For this purpose, the Government is conducting three surveys namely Survey of Registered Industries (ASI), Labour Force Survey (LFS) and Survey of Unincorporated Sector Enterprises (SUSE). Using the data collected through these surveys DDP is estimated which can augment the need-based planning for the district. Assam is one of the first states in the nation to undertake the endeavor of DDP estimation using this new approach. This Division is working on this Project with 'Pehle India Foundation (PIF) - a leading policy think tank of India' which is supporting on various technical dimensions such as research, capacity building and conducting surveys etc.

ii) Agriculture Statistics Division:

The main function of this division are to conduct Digital Crop Estimation Survey (DGCES), collection, compilation and maintaining of agricultural statistics, preparation of Land Utilization Statistics(LUS) Report and organize the Annual Refresher Training on agriculture statistics etc. Being the State Agricultural Statistics Authority (SASA), it analyses the crop area, average yield and production of 46 Nos. of crops of Assam.

The division also collects, compiles and analyses data under the following schemes/Programs:

a) Digital General Crop Estimation Survey (DGCES): The DGCES consists of performing a specified number of Crop Cutting Experiments in randomly selected fields. Crop Cutting Experiments are conducted under well designed survey technique for estimating the average yield. In a sub sample of the experiment, driage operation is also performed to get driage ratio in case of Paddy, Maize and dry fiber ratio in case of Jute.

The DGCES is a nationwide initiative aimed at precisely assessing crop yields across a variety of crops. This program utilizes a meticulously crafted survey methodology rooted in the principles of Crop Cutting Experiments (CCE). The introduction of the DGCES on mobile application and portal has ushered in a transformative era for recording CCE results directly from the field. With innovative features such as GPS-enabled photo capture and automated plot selection, this technological advancement significantly enhances transparency and accuracy within the system. The DGCES is the digital version of Crop Estimation Survey for capturing data by using Mobile Application and Web Portal

b) Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY): PMFBY is a flagship crop insurance scheme to provide financial protection to farmers against crop losses due to natural calamities, pests and diseases. The scheme holds particular importance due to the vulnerability to flood and erratic weather conditions of our state. For effective implementation and claim settlement

CCEs are conducted by hired field workers engaged by the Directorate of Agriculture under the supervision of this Directorate. The data collected through these CCEs play a crucial role in assessing crop yield and determining insurance payout, thereby supporting the broader objective of ensuring income stability and resilience among farmers in the state.

c) Improvement of Crop Statistics (ICS): The programme of supervision under ICS Scheme has been carried out on equal matching basis with the NDO (FOD) as per guidelines of the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation, Govt. of India.

d) Crop Forecast of area, production and average yield of 46 (forty six) nos. of crops and Land Utilization Statistics are also prepared from this division.

iii) Timely Reporting Scheme (TRS) Section: The Directorate has a TRS Section also. The main function of this section is to timely estimate the area under 13 (thirteen) principal crops on the basis of 20% of sample villages in the plain Districts at the end of each season viz. Early Kharif, Late Kharif, Rabi and Summer. This section also performs the Sample survey on Arecanut, Coconut, Fruits and Vegetables to find out the crop growing area of Arecanut, Coconut, Fruits and Vegetables and to estimate average yield and production of Arecanut and Coconut

iv) Agriculture Census Division:

There is an Agriculture Census division under this Directorate. The main function of this division is to conduct Agriculture Census at every five year interval regularly as per Govt. of India guidelines and prepare the report. Agriculture Census is a large scale statistical operation under the Central Sector Scheme funded by the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmer's Welfare, Government of India under supervision of Directorate of Economics and Statistics, Assam where detailed quantitative information of land holding are collected by taking Agriculture holding as a basic unit of operation. Land Record Assistant of the revenue circle offices work as enumerator of the Census work through Agriculture App.

V) Training Division:

The Training Division arranges various training programs for Junior Statistical personnel, newly recruited officials and takes initiative to depute the officials to undergo training courses within and outside the State organized by Central and State Governments for their capacity building in different field of activities of the Directorate.

vi) Survey Division:

Survey Division conducts National Sample Survey in different rounds under the guidance of National Statistical Office, Govt. of India and also Employment & Unemployment Survey under the guidance of Labour Bureau, Govt. of India. Assam

Government Employees Census and some ad-hoc surveys are also conducted by this division from time to time as and when necessary.

vii) Statistical Data Division:

The primary work of this Division is to collect, analyze and disseminate the statistical data collected from various secondary sources (Govt. and non-govt. organizations). This division also brings out the publications of 'Statistical Hand Book, Assam', 'Assam at a Glance', Statistical Abstract and Key Statistics of Atlas on regular basis.

viii) Economic Study Division including AIU: The sole function of this division is to study and analyze socio-economic scenario of the state, with details sector wise Socio-economic parameters. 'Economic Survey, Assam' is one of the important annual publications of this division.

There is another sub unit AIU attached with this Division. The main function of this section is to collect data from 219 Community Development Blocks and updating the village Index and Block Information Register with different indicators viz. Agriculture, Forestry, Classification of Workers etc.

ix) Industry Division:

The main activities of the division are to conduct Annual Survey of Industries (ASI) as per selection of the registered factories/ industries provided by Enterprise Survey Division, MoSPI, Govt of India, collection of Monthly Production Data (MPD) from organized and selected Manufacturing Industries, Mines& Minerals and Generation of Electricity and construction of Index of Industrial Production (IIP) as well as Mineral Index on major minerals for the state of Assam. Besides these, this division collects the Annual Tea Statistics return and prepares a report on Calendar Year basis.

x) Price Section:

The main activities of this section are collection of Farm Harvest Price, preparation of Wholesale Price Index (WPI) of Agricultural commodities and Consumer Price Index (CPI) and also preparation of monthly statement of Wholesale Prices and Retail prices (For both Urban & Rural areas) of essential commodities. Moreover, collection and compilation of prices of different building materials together with preparation of monthly statement of wage rate of building construction workers and Agricultural Labours are also the main functions of this section.

xi) Information Technology and Data Processing Division:

Data processing of various surveys and censuses and updating of web site of this Directorate are the main functions of this division.

xii) Besides above, for strengthening the Directorate's data base a **Support for Statistical Strengthening (SSS) Cell has been set up during the year 2018-19 for smooth implementation of **SSS** Scheme. The scheme is fully funded by the**

Central Govt. to bridge the data gap and create a data base for future planning of the state.

The main functions of this Cell are to conduct some pilot surveys and studies and capacity development of statistical personnel of the Directorate and line Departments.

For implementation of the scheme the Govt. of Assam has constituted "**State High Level Steering Committee (SHLSC)**" headed by the Chief Secretary to the Govt. of Assam and "**State Implementation Committee (SIC)**" headed by the Senior Most Secretary to the Govt. of Assam, Transformation and Development Department.

8. INFRASTRUCTURE DETAILS (OFFICE BUILDING):

The Headquarter of the Directorate of Economics and Statistics, Assam is functioning in its own office buildings located at Tripura Road, Jawaharnagar, Guwahati-28. At present, there are 16 (sixteen) offices namely the Joint Director of Economics and Statistics (Hills), Diphu, the Deputy Director of Economics and Statistics, Bongaigaon, Jorhat, Sivasagar, Karbi-Anglong, Dima Hasao, NorthLakhimpur, Goalpara, Nagaon, Nalbari, Barpeta , Sonitpur and Sub-Disional Statistical Offices Tinsukia, Dhemaji, Marigaon and Hamren are functioning from their own office buildings. Moreover, the Sub-Disional Statistics Office Sadiya is functioning in Government Building and restsof the Offices are functioning from rented building. It can be also mentioned that, there is no any departmental residential quarter for the officials and staff under this Directorate in the headquarter as well as in District and Sub-division offices except in the district of Karbi-Anglong .

The Directorate has a Library with sizeable stock of different books, journals, publications, magazines, periodical, reports, reviews etc. relating to Economics, Statistics and other related subjects which is very useful for the staff in performing their various statistical activities. Moreover, the books and publications of this Directorate are very helpful for the Researcher in pursuing their work in the related field.

Besides this, the Directorate has a modest training hall and well equipped Conference hall at headquarter (Guwahati) where departmental trainings and high level officials' discussion are organized from time to time for capacity building of officials of the Directorate.

9. CAPACITY BUILDING INITIATIVE DURING 2024-25:

(Training/Workshop):

During the FY 2024-25, the Directorate of Economics and Statistics has under taken various training programs for capacity building of Statistical personnel and accordingly the officials were deputed to National Statistical Systems Training Academy (NSSTA), Greater Noida, UP, Assam Administrative Staff College (AASC), Khanapara, Guwahati-22,VivantaTaj, Khanapara, Faridabad, Haryana, Assam

Institute of Research for Tribals and Scheduled Castes on various subjects such as Constitutional Law and Governance, e-Prastuti, e-Procurement &GeM, Good Governance, Right to Information Act, ARTPS and other Transparency Measures, e-Office, Kritagyata, Accounts & Financial Rules and Duties & Responsibilities of DDOs, Change Management in Workplace, Statistical Training Needs Assessment Tool, Wellness and Mental Health, etc. Following table shows the details training programs of the DES, Assam during 2024-25.

10. VARIOUS STUDIES/ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED BY THE DES, ASSAM UNDER SSS:

The SSS Sub-scheme envisaged to undertake 38 Nos. of Surveys/Studies consisting Large Scale Studies, Large Scale Field Surveys, Constructions of Indices, Village Level Database, Tourism Convenience Index, IOTT and Methodology Improvement. Apart from the 38 Nos. of Surveys/Studies the Scheme also envisaged to achieve required capacity development through 123 Nos. of training and 4 Nos. of exposure visits, specialized training etc. The Scheme also envisaged to popularize Statistics amongst the youth and general masses with celebration of Statistics Day and organization of seminars, stake holder meets etc.

21 Nos. of Surveys/Studies has been undertaken under SSS so far through IIT (G), UNDP, Cotton University, Tezpur University, NEHU, RGVN, NCAER, OKDISCD and Assam University. Out of these 21 Nos. of Surveys/Studies, 15 tasks has been completed and report published (6 Nos. of reports are available at DES website), 6 Nos. of Surveys/Studies are in progress. In addition to the above mentioned Surveys/Studies, 61 Nos. of training have been undertaken for capacity development of the statistical personnel of the Directorate as well as the Line Departments and also 2 Nos. of seminars were also held for popularization of statistics among the young generation.

11. DETAILS OF COURT CASES:

There are 5 Nos. of W.P. (C) Court Cases under the Hon'ble Gauhati High Court pending against this Directorate relating to appointment of Director, DES, pension and promotion etc. During 2024-25, 1(one) of the cases have already been disposed by the Hon'ble Gauhati High Court and 4 (four) cases are under process.

Besides the above mentioned cases one legal notice regarding pensioner benefits was also received and served to the concerned office during the year 2024-25.

12. PUBLICATION:
